



## Abstract Guidelines

Concerning the layout of your abstract please keep to the following guidelines:

File Format	PDF or Word Files may contain embedded graphics. But consider longer transmission times and timeout problems. Files should not exceed 10 MB. Invalid files cause complete cancellation of your submission.
Volume	At least 2 - 4 pages, maximum 6 pages
Page Format	DIN A 4 (29,7 cm height, 21 cm width),
Font	Arial, 12 pt
Margins	left/right: 2,3 cm; above/below: 3 cm
1 <sup>st</sup> paragraph	Empty
2 <sup>nd</sup> paragraph	Title of the paper (bold face)
3 <sup>rd</sup> paragraph	Authors of the contribution in the format Main author, initials, city/country code, Co-author(s) in the same format, Address of the main author
4 <sup>th</sup> paragraph	Contents of the abstract
Foot-notes	Do not use Word foot-notes. Please write citations in normal text (Arial 12 pt) at the end of the document.
Publication	Presentations or abstracts created for the Late Summer Workshop will be distributed to the participants of the workshop as pdf-file.

The compliance with the guidelines is very important because the abstracts will not be revised by the Waterchemistry Society or the GDCh.
